

Garden Tidy Up for Spring!

Don't Forget:

- Ask an adult to help you
- Don't pick any live plants unless your grown up tells you to.
- Only collect things that are no longer wanted in the garden like dead leaves, twigs or weeds.
- Don't pick up anything that looks yucky or dangerous
- Wash your hands
- Have fun!

What to do



- Wear gloves & use 2 long sticks to pick up litter.
- Take a bucket to put your litter in, then get your adult to decanter into a rubbish bag.
- Put the garden waste into your compost heap or bin.



Remember – even in your garden or park -

- Do not touch anything sharp, unhygienic or with a hazard label.
- Do not touch face/mouth during your garden tidy up.
- WASH HANDS after you've been in the garden and BEFORE YOU DO ANYTHING ELSE.
- Do not fill bags more than halfway.
- Do not lift anything heavy.
